## Directions from Russell Square to ULU (Picadilly Line)



## From Russell Square to ULU

1. Exit the tube station, turning left onto Bernard Street (photograph ❶).
2. Walk along Bernard Street to the traffic lights.
3. Cross over the road, and walk along the north side of Russell Square past the Post Office (photograph ❷).
4. Cross over the zebra crossing at the bottom of Bedford Way and continue past the bus stop (photograph ❸).
5. Just past the bus stop turn right off Russell Square onto Thornhaugh Street (photograph ❹), following the cycle path.
6. Turn immediately left onto Torrington Square (photograph ❺). You are now walking through the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS).
7. Continue to the other end of Torrington Square. You will have a grassy area on your right and the north wing of Senate House on your left<sup>1</sup>. Turn right onto Malet Street (photograph ❻).
8. Walk up Malet Street. ULU is at the top on the right hand side (photograph ❼).

<sup>1</sup> When writing 1984, George Orwell worked for the University of London in Senate House. He based the Ministry of Love building on it. Moreover Room 101, the infamous torture chamber, was based on Senate House's Room 101 – the Vice-Chancellor's office.
